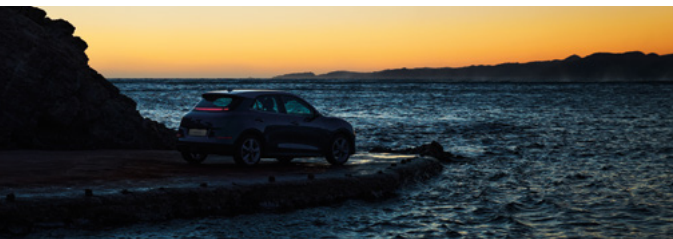

Charging tips

1. ORA 03 comes with a CCS socket, capable of charging 15-80% in just 42mins using a DC rapid charger (max charging 67kW)
2. Use a wall charger at home to reach 15-80% in 5hrs 40mins
3. If you're out and about, charge to 15-100% in 3hrs 20mins using a 11kw public charger
4. It's best to top up your ORA 03 to just 80% battery capacity, when possible
5. Set the desired charging limit to prevent unnecessary electricity usage
[select 'All Apps' Icon > Power Assistant > Charging Management]
6. Always unlock your car before plugging in your charging cable and then lock in place
7. There is a yellow manual release cable for the charging socket inside the bonnet, on the passenger side, just below the windscreen
8. Find public charging points by saying 'Hello ORA, find nearest charging station' or use tools like ZapMap and Octopus Electroverse

Battery & Range

ORA 03 is available with a 48kWh or 63kWh battery, offering up to 193 or 260 WLTP electric miles respectively.

Electric vehicle range is affected by several factors – external temperature, driving style and in-car functions such as climate control. ORA 03 has an adaptive range feature that shows a representation of your real-world range based on previous journeys. This is why you might see a lower range, even when the battery is at 100%.

Infotainment

You'll find almost all settings via the main infotainment screen – from satellite navigation to radio, vehicle safety, display and more. You can use the left-hand steering wheel button cluster to control this.

The screen directly in front of the steering wheel only displays driver information and is controlled via the right-hand steering wheel button cluster. Here you can view trip data and real time traffic data.

Core functions, such as safety systems, are set to default 'on'. So when choosing preferences before you travel, if you turn off any safety features, they'll revert to 'on' for your next trip.

Climate Control

Heat or cool your ORA 03 using the 'Hello ORA' voice assistant or by using the temperature slider on the infotainment screen. You can also perform basic climate control functions with the physical buttons (middle of dashboard, below screen).

For heating, make sure the 'sun icon' is switched 'on' to activate the climate control system.

ORA 03 comes with an intuitive and friendly voice assistant to make driving even easier.

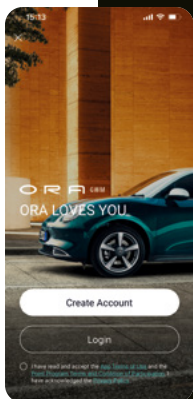
Say "Hello ORA..." to perform a host of functions from "...open the window" to "...turn up the volume".

Advanced Driver Assistance Systems (ADAS)

Thanks to comprehensive ADAS, ORA 03 has a 5-star Euro NCAP safety rating and was commended as one of the 2023 top 10 safest cars launched in the UK.

As standard, ORA 03 comes with 360° surround cameras, adaptive smart cruise control, lane change assist, blind spot detection, traffic sign recognition, auto emergency braking and rear cross traffic alert and brake.
